- 2. **Infection-**: Bacterial, Viral fungi, antimicrobial agents (antibiotics) Sulphonamides, Trimethoprim. Cotrimaxazole, Penicillin, Amoxicillin, Ciprofloxacin, Erythromycin, tetracycline, Chloramphenical etc. Anti mycobacterium antiviral Drugs and Anti fungal Drugs.
- 3. **Infections and Tropical Diseases-**: Poliomyelitis, Whooping cough, Diphtheria, Tetanus, Typhoid fever, food poisoning Cholera, amoebiasis, malaria Worms (Round, hook, whip, tapeworm) Syphilis, Gonorrhea, AIDS.
